Enclosure No. 1: Guidelines and Mechanics for the Search for Best Reading Ambassadors

General:

1. There shall only be one (1) entry per municipality in the following categories:

Elementary teacher (Filipino)	Elementary learner (Filipino)
Elementary teacher (English)	Elementary learner (English)
Secondary teacher (Filipino)	Secondary learner (Filipino)
Secondary teacher (English)	Secondary learner (English)

- 2. Contestants are required to submit a video recording (5-10 minutes, which includes the question and answer portion) showcasing a reading performance. The video should:
 - a. feature a teacher/learner reading aloud a chosen passage or story to a group of 10-15 learners who belong in the frustration level in reading performance, regardless of their grade level.
 - b. The video should showcase effective reading techniques, expressive reading, and an interactive question-and-answer session between the reader and learners.
- 3. All video recordings and supporting documents must be submitted online on or before **November 26, 2024, through email address** <u>markcarlo.buyao@deped.gov.ph</u>. The required documents are the following: List of names of reader and his/her learners (audience) with signature of the school head, copy of the reading passage, and questions asked during the reading session.
- 4. The reading ambassadors may wear school uniform or any attire suitable for the story.
- 5. A Committee will be created to review video submissions and evaluate based on the criteria.
- 6. A Certificate of Commendation and a cash prize will be given to the winners in the Teachers' Category, and a medal and a cash prize will be given to the Learners' Category.
